## The Legislature and the Internet

All Minnesota legislators have their own e-mail addresses at the State Capitol and can be reached by using them. If you have access to the Internet, a wealth of legislative information is available in addition to members' e-mail addresses — including committee schedules, bill language and all of the information in the weekly mailings. You can log on to the Minnesota legislature at [www.leg.mn](http://www.leg.mn).

## House of Representatives

**House Information Office: 651-296-2146, 800-657-3550**

Located in the first floor of the State Office Building. Contact this office to:

- add your name to the e-mail list so you'll receive weekly e-mails during session and summaries after they end;
- determine who your legislators are;
- receive copies of directories, committee assignments, schedules;
- get limitless information on the legislature and other branches of state government.

**Chief Clerk's Office: 651-296-2314**

Contact the Chief Clerk's office, located on the Capitol's second floor, for:

- copies of daily journals during session;
- copies of bills;
- copies of House calendars, Calendar for the Day and Fiscal Calendar.

**House Index: 651-296-6646**

Contact this office, located immediately adjacent to the Chief Clerk's office, for information on:

- bill authors;
- bill numbers;
- bill status.

You can use public computers in the House index office to obtain current information on bills and action taken upon them.

## Senate

**Office of the Secretary of the Senate: 651-296-2344, 888-234-1112**

Located on the Capitol Building's second floor, this office will provide copies of bills, schedules, calendars, etc. It is the counterpart to the House Chief Clerk's Office.

**Senate Index/Senate Information Office: 651-296-0504, 651-296-2887, 888-234-1112**

Located on the second floor of the Capitol, this combined office can answer questions about Senate district boundaries and provide you with general information regarding the Senate, the legislative process and Senators' addresses, phone numbers and committee assignments. They will also provide information on bills, authors, and action taken on bills.
